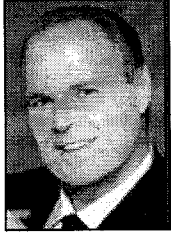

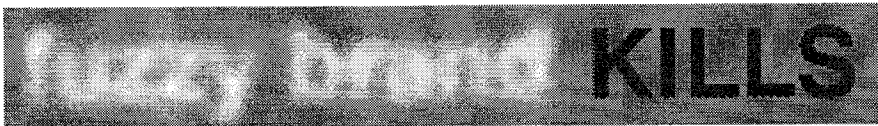
## Rush Limbaugh Wants Medical Records Sealed

### ■ Stop to 'unauthorized' public disclosure sought



Premiere Radio Networks-syndicated talk host Rush Limbaugh (pictured) on Monday filed a motion with a Palm Beach County, FL circuit court judge that sought a ruling on his request to prevent any "unauthorized" public disclosure of his personal medical records. Limbaugh also asked that a hearing be convened within three days to rule on the request. According to the *Palm Beach Daily News*, Limbaugh claimed he enjoys a constitutional right to privacy over the medical records and that the seizure of the records by the Florida State Attorney's Office was making it difficult for him to obtain treatment from his physicians. Limbaugh's records were seized in late November after the State Attorney's Office obtained warrants alleging the talk host received prescription medication of a controlled substance from four physicians in a five-month period earlier this year — a move some claim was done to obtain overlapping prescriptions. Limbaugh's attorney, Roy Black, said at the time that the warrants amounted to "a fishing expedition."

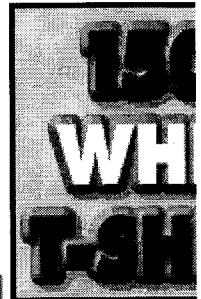

## Michael Powell Urges Radio To Go Digital

### ■ Says medium is in danger of falling behind



Pointing out that digital technology is spreading to most forms of media, the FCC Chairman said yesterday that the radio industry needs to adopt HD Radio if it hopes to compete in the future. "Everything had better go digital, or you're playing with your very survival," he said at a Q&A session at the National Press Club, where he was a featured speaker. Powell warned that the generation currently growing up in the digital age will expect a lot from media when they reach adulthood. "Look at your children and pay attention to what their expectations are for information interaction and gathering" he said. "There is one generation of kids that are growing up digital, and they are about 13 or 14 right now, and when they're in their 20s and they are your customers, you're going to be surprised to see how the world has changed." 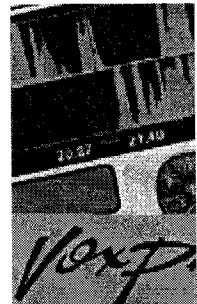
