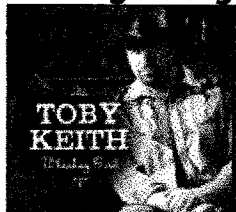

## NEW Revenue Stream for Radio Stations!!!

#### It's KOOL In Phoenix

The Oldies station again tops the market in the winter 2004 Phase Two Arbitrends despite a 5.9-5.6 dip. No. 2 KNIX stays at 5.4. In Salt Lake City, perennial leader KSFI drops 9.3-8.8 but still holds onto first place, and WFMS stays steady at 11.0 to sit on top in Indianapolis. WQUE rises 11.2-11.4 in New Orleans to keep the No. 1 position, while WAMZ lengthens its lead in Louisville by rocketing 13.2-14.3. In Dayton, WHKO keeps at 10.1 and retains the top spot. Also released Friday: Tucson and Omaha. More details in Ratings.

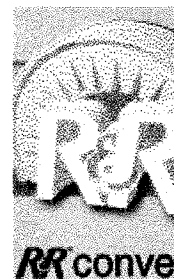

**Triple A's 'Breathe' Heavily**

■ Etheridge is Lucky with new album's success



Melissa Etheridge ascends to the top spot on R&R's Triple A chart this week with "Breathe" (Island/IDJMG), the first single from her album *Lucky*. The song, a cover version of a track originally done by labelmate Greenwheel, is headed toward the top 10 at Hot AC as well. Etheridge just celebrated her 15th year recording for Island.

She's currently in the midst of a mostly East Coast tour that will visit such major cities as Chicago, Philadelphia, New York, Boston, Orlando and Detroit and conclude in Dallas on May 21.

Infinity's Oldies KOOL repeats at No. 1 in Phoenix's winter 2004 Phase One Arbitrends, moving 6.0-5.9. KNIX stays in second, and KESZ is again in third. KSFI maintains its big Salt Lake City lead, WFMS remains on top in Indianapolis, and WQUE sees another win in New Orleans.
